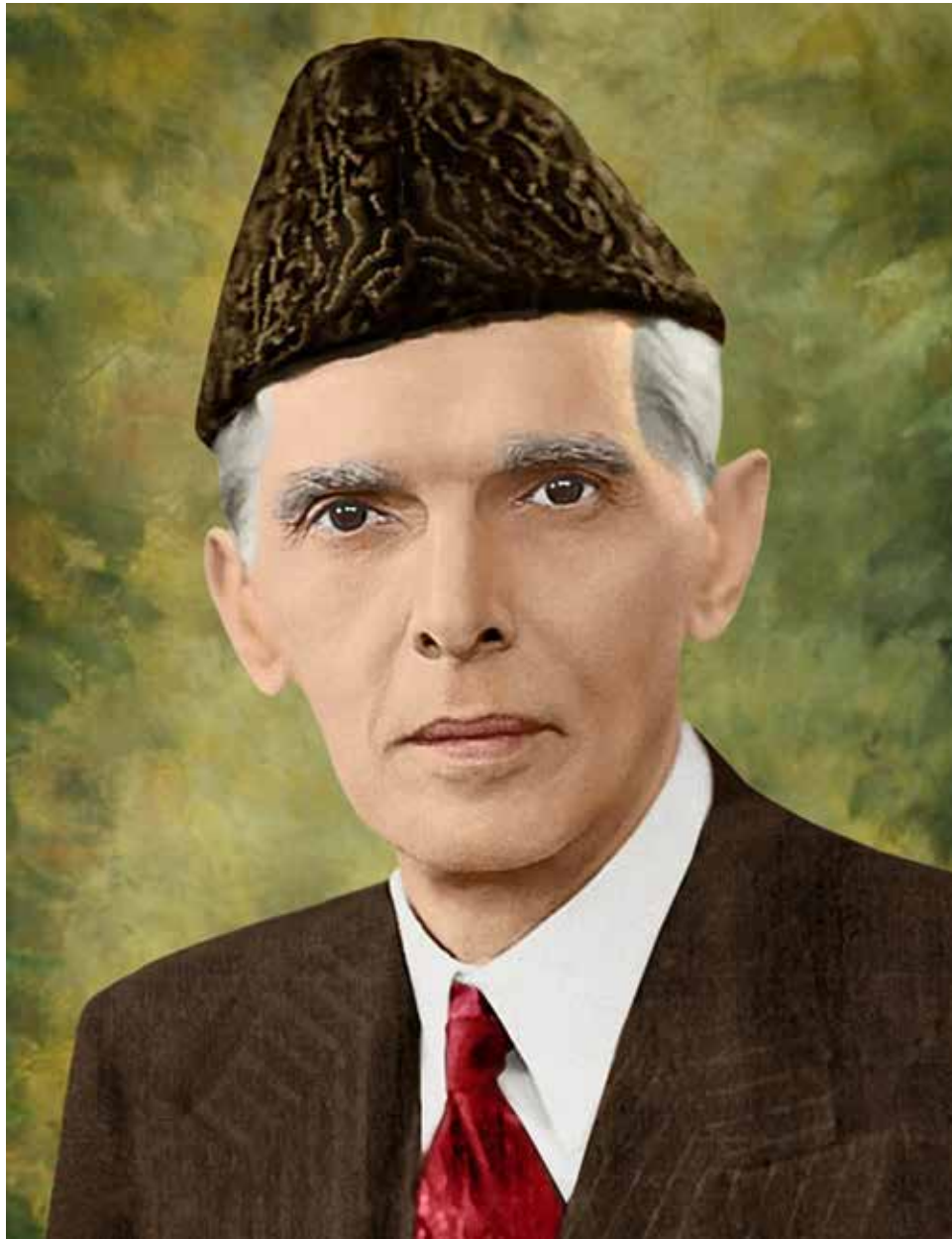

DEPARTMENTAL PROFILES

Anaesthesia, Intensive Care & Pain Management Department

Professor Jodat Saleem

The Department of Anaesthesia and ICU is a dynamic teaching unit of PGMI/AMC/LGH headed by Professor Jodat Saleem.

The faculty consists of five Assistant Professors, five Senior Registrars and two anesthetists. The Department is providing anaesthesia services for elective and emergency cases including 43 operation theatres at 11 different areas. It provides clinical services to the specialties of general surgery, obstetrics and gynaecology, urology, neurosurgery, ENT, Ophthalmology, Plastic Surgery and orthopedic surgery. In addition, the Department is also providing services in two surgical critical care units having 6 and 10 beds. The department also provides sedation and monitoring cover to gastroenterology and radiology department. In 2017, 33000 patients were administered general anaesthesia and more than 1100 patients were managed in intensive care. The department is also providing acute and chronic pain management services. Our department has an elaborated and well organized training, teaching and evaluation programs for post graduate trainees. The program comprises of weekly clinical meeting and audit, journal club and case presentation, guest lecturer and skill demonstration. The department has 24 hours internet facility computer room and conference room. The unit has work guidelines and SOPs in accordance with MSDS for smooth and standardized working. Currently, department is running four post graduate courses and training for DA, MCPS, MS and FCPS. The training is also recognized by Irish Medical Council, KSA and UK. Presently department has more than 60 post graduates pursuing their career in the field of anaesthesia and intensive care management. Our future vision is to establish a full time pain clinic, to start postgraduate training in critical care, provision of pain relief services in obstetric department and establishment of pre anesthesia clinic in OPD.



Anatomy Department

Professor Fauzia Farzana

The Anatomy Department has been an academic pillar of the institute since its inception in 1974. Respectable Professor Dr. Fauzia Farzana is the head, Dr. Mariam Saad is Associate Professor and Dr. Muhammad Sharjeel Ilyas, Dr. Sadia Shakeel and Dr. Shagufta Nasreen are the Assistant Professors in this unit. There are 10 (regular, adhoc and contract) demonstrators under the kind and experienced supervision of Prof. Fauzia Farzana who maintains a spirit of new discoveries and adventure in all the academic activities and research work. The faculty of the department includes senior and well-respected teachers who have brought with them a rich and varied experience of teaching in some of the most prestigious and premier institutions of the province.

The department has an elaborate and well-organized training, teaching and evaluation program for undergraduate and postgraduate students where all the faculty members are actively involved in teaching and professional training of M.B.B.S. class, teaching/research programs of postgraduate students including M. Phil and clinical diplomas like DCP, DA, DPM, DMRD, DIP. CARD, DCH, DGO, DTCD, DMRT and DMJ. The department of Anatomy is conducting several research projects by postgraduate students. The teaching programs comprise of special classes for all the students, postgraduate power point presentations, training sessions, tests, OSPE practice and viva preparation for the professional and postgraduate examinations. There is a dissection hall which caters to the maintenance and preservation of cadavers, which are allotted to students so that they may learn the basis of gross anatomy by dissecting the regions allotted to them along with a museum equipped with all kinds of gross, histological and embryological models and specimens of human bodies. Likewise, there is a purpose-built histology laboratory equipped with standard microscopes and a teaching microscope with four eyepieces. Lecture halls are available which are shared by other basic departments with teaching schedules prepared accordingly. The teaching staff has a professor's office, associate professor's office, a common demonstrators' room and a computer room. The department and faculty members hope to give rise to an extremely dedicated class of well-trained professionals who serve the nation whole-heartedly and selflessly every year.

Biochemistry Department

The department is headed by Professor Dr. Anila Asghar. There are two Assistant Professors, Dr. Quratulain Siddiqui, Dr. Sohaib Farooq, two senior demonstrators and demonstrators. The department has its own laboratory with lab staff, senior lab technicians, junior lab technicians for the purpose of teaching of students of 1st and 2nd years MBBS and students of M.Phil Biochemistry. The biochemistry department is involved in teaching and training undergraduate students of MBBS in Biochemistry subject, teaching and training postgraduate students of M.Phil Biochemistry, guiding and supervising students in the subject of Biochemistry. The department is also involved in teaching of subject of biochemistry to students of clinical diplomas and other disciplines. The department is keen to participate in all the activities taking place in the academic year, promotion of student-teacher relationship. The faculty members being the members of different societies. The department is involved in research activities. The department is always interested in improvement in teaching programmes of undergraduate and post graduate teaching.

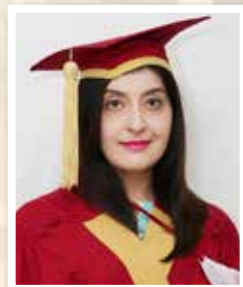


Dermatology Department

Dr. Kehkshan Tahir

Dermatology unit is a 25 bedded teaching unit of Lahore General Hospital/PGMI/AMC. Dr. Kehkshan Tahir is the Head and Assistant Professor of this unit. There are six senior registrars and two consultant dermatologists in this unit. This unit provides 6 days OPD services where 400 patients have been looked after daily by consultants. Moreover, daily evening OPD services are also provided by the department. There are three procedure rooms for providing various diagnostic and therapeutic facilities, Phototherapy & LASERS. This department has well structured and planned training, teaching and evaluation programmes for house officers, undergraduates and postgraduates. This unit is recognized for various postgraduate training programmes (FCPS, MD and MCPS) since last five years. This programme comprises of daily consultant rounds, OPD teachings, weekly CPC and Journal club, slide sessions and lectures by supervisor, dermatopathology classes and monthly assessments on examination patterns. Postgraduates from other disciplines of Medicine & Ophthalmology get their compulsory training for dermatology in this department.

This unit has working guidelines and SOPs for smooth and standard working under MSDS programme. This unit provides a good collection of updated books, class room and 24 hour internet facility to its residents. Department of dermatology is actively engaged in research projects & 21 papers have been published in renowned journals during last five years. There are 12 clinical research projects currently going on in the department.



DEPARTMENTAL PROFILES

Forensic Medicine & Toxicology Department

Dr. Pervaiz Zarif

Department of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology is a Paraclinical / Basic Department being the only department at present which exists at both places (6-Birdwood Road, Lahore as Academic Campus and at Lahore General Hospital, Lahore as Mortuary and Medicolegal Clinic). Presently it is being run under the supervision of Dr. Pervaiz Zarif, Assistant Professor who alone looks after both sites.

Mortuary is one of the most recent addition to Lahore General Hospital, Lahore which started functioning in December, 2016, with 17 Police Stations of Lahore attached to it where Demonstrators Medicolegal are working round the clock. Annual Load of autopsies is 100 – 125, whereas these demonstrators also perform round the clock duty in Accident and Emergency Department in Medicolegal Clinic which has load of 8 Police Stations of Lahore with annual no. of 3000 plus cases.

In addition to this, PG students of Postgraduate Medical Institute and undergraduate students of Ameer-ud-Din Medical College are also taught clinical skills of autopsy and medicolegal at both places. Also students of other private medical colleges come to observe autopsy and medicolegal work here.

At 6-Birdwood Road campus, PG classes for M.Phil Forensic Medicine and Diploma in Medical Jurisprudence (DMJ) are underway and every year 10 students of DMJ and 6 students of M.Phil get enrollment here and the result is excellent due to extensive training. At undergraduate level last three years result shows that 100% students passed and also got distinctions. Besides this, the departmental staff also imparts training to those doctors working in the periphery in collaboration with the Office of Surgeon Medicolegal, Punjab.



Medical Education Department

The department of Medical Education has been established in Ameer ud Din Medical College / Postgraduate Medical Institute according to the PMDC regulations. This Department is headed by Prof. Muhammad Moin. There are 11 members in this department including Prof. Muhammad Tayyab, Prof. Muhammad Farooq Afzal, Prof. Najam ul Hasnanin Khan, Prof. Imran Hassan Khan, Prof. Alia Bashir, Prof. Agha Shabbir Ali, Prof. Muhammad Shahid, Prof. Muniza Saeed, Prof. Fauzia Farzana, Prof. Asif Bashir and Dr. Saria Gulzar. The department is responsible for monitoring the curriculum, Time tables, Faculty Development, Examinations and Admissions of the Under graduate and Postgraduate students, lecture, and Liaison with international exam bodies..

Medical Unit-I

Professor Ghias-un-Nabi Tayyab

MEDICAL UNIT-I & GI Unit is a 60 bedded Internal Medicine and 40 bedded gastroenterology teaching and training unit of LGH and is headed by Prof. Dr. Ghias-un-Nabi Tayyab. The unit is managed by a strong team of highly qualified, motivated & experienced faculty comprising of one Associate Professor, 4 Assistant Professors, 8 Senior Registrars and 50 post-graduate trainees in Internal Medicine & Gastroenterology. Department is recognized by CPSP for training in MD Medicine and FCPS Medicine & Gastroenterology by UHS and Royal College of Medicine UK. Department has also been declared center of excellence for teaching and training in Gastroenterology by health authorities of Punjab.



The department offers a strong teaching and training program commensurate with requirements of MD, FCPS and MRCP and number of trainees from this unit are working in other hospitals of Pakistan and abroad after a successful completion of the training and attaining the post graduate certification. The key features of the training program are an intensive bedside clinical teaching rota along with formal seminars, mortality conference, MDT's and journal clubs. Twice a week medical OPD, Gastroenterology OPD along with 48 hours per week A & E cover provide adequate patient exposure to the candidates in the training. Being the senior unit, all the academic and administrative rosters for the department of medicine are issued from the office of this unit in consultation with other stakeholders.

Luminal diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopic procedures, hepatobiliopancreatic endoscopy, endoscopic ultrasound, functional GI Lab, neurogastromotility and other image guided procedures like radio frequency ablation of the hepatocellular carcinoma etc are offered to the patients coming to this hospital from across Pakistan. Department has successfully hosted two international GI conferences, in addition to numerous hands on endoscopy, ERCP, and EUS workshops and Live endoscopy workshops. Department has also played a leading role in management of dengue disease and capacity building of human resource and infrastructure for control of dengue in Punjab.

Medical Unit-II

Dr. Muhammad Imran Hassan Khan

Medical Unit II LGH is a 65 bedded, with Associate Prof. Dr. Muhammad Imran Hasan Khan as Head, Dr. Maliha Hameed, Dr. Fatima Hamdani and Dr. Kashif Aziz Ahmad as Assistant Professors and six Senior Registrars. The unit is currently recognized by UHS and CPSP for training in MD Medicine and FCPS Medicine. Applications are submitted in both above institutes for recognition of training in MD Endocrinology and FCPS Endocrinology.



Medical Unit II has additional responsibility of 8 bedded Medical ICU, and infectious diseases isolation ward. We run 48 hour emergency every week with same day outpatients, and every third special Sunday. Approximately 25000 patients were seen in last one year in Diabetes Endocrine and Metabolic Center (DEMC) and more than 50,000 in Medical OPD. Weekly admissions through emergency are around 60 in our unit. We are also running DEMC, 6 days a week. From 2011, this center is computerized. More than 14000 patients are registered, with majority of them with majority of them being Diabetics. Outlier team of Senior Registrars deals with diabetes endocrine calls in other departments during day time. We receive frequent calls for Pituitary, Thyroid, and other Endocrine problems. We also have a short stay area in ward for special endocrine tests and beds for Endocrine patients. Regular ward teaching in early morning hours for Postgraduate students is carried out 4 days a week. During last 2 years, we organized more than 15 workshops, 10 symposia, 46 posters in various national and international conferences and published 8 papers in national and international journals. The dynamic team of Medical unit 2 is committed towards medicine, and passionate about Diabetes, Endocrine and Metabolism recognition as second specialty in this unit.

DEPARTMENTAL PROFILES

Medical Unit-III

Professor Farah Shafi

Medical Unit-III is a 64 bedded Teaching Unit of Lahore General Hospital/AMC. Prof. Dr. Farah Shafi is the Head of Department. Dr. Raffad is Associate Professor and Dr. Amir Riaz is Assistant Professor of this unit. There are five Senior Registrars Dr. Abdul Qadoss, Dr. Bilal Azeem Butt, Dr. Bushra Hashmi, Dr. Fizan Ahmad and Dr. Sana Fatima. This unit admits about 6000 patient per year. This unit has two OPD days in which average 1300-1400 patients per week are seen. More over Rheumatology and Echocardiography facility is available.

This department has an elaborate and well organized training, teaching and evaluation program for Postgraduates, House officers and undergraduates. This program comprises of daily Clinical meetings, Journal club, Case presentation, Test and TOACS on Examination pattern. Unit has working guidelines and SOPs for smooth and standard working. Department has Library, Class room, Research room and Computer room. This unit is recognized for post graduation training in FCPS and MD.



Nephrology Department

Nephrology unit is a 12 bedded unit of Lahore general hospital / Ameer-un-Deen Medical Collage Lahore. Dr. Aurangzeb Afzal is the Head of Department. There are five senior registrars in the department. Dr. Yasir Hussain, Dr. Roshina Anjum, Dr. Sidra Saleem, Dr. Anjum Shehzad and Dr. Sajid Iqbal.

This unit admits about 1000 patients per year. This unit has two OPD days where average 28200 patients are seen. In addition to these, unit is also providing services for 30 bedded dialysis unit including maintenance and 24 hour emergency dialysis services.

Dr. Aurangzeb Afzal is the approved supervisor for MD and FCPS nephrology and organized teaching programmes for post graduates, house officers and undergraduates. The unit has work guidelines and SOPs for smooth and standard working. The Department has dedicated procedure room. This unit is the first nephrology unit where large number of permanent dialysis catheterization and renal biopsies are being done free of cost. The unit also has the pride to provide novel therapies like rituximab to poor and deserving patients. Management of Renal transplant is just a routine work of the unit. We have the honour to have more than thirteen research papers in renowned journals.

Neurology Department

Professor Ahsan Numan

Neurology department is a 40 bedded teaching unit of PGMI/PINS/AMC/ Lahore General Hospital, Lahore. Prof. Ahsan Numan is leading the department, Dr. Mohsin Zaheer is the Associate Professor while Assistant Professors include Dr. Shahid Mukhtar, Dr. Rashid Imran, Dr. Syed Arslan Haider. The unit admits about 1440 patients per year. The Unit has six (06) days a week OPD services with both morning and evening shifts (timings: 08:00am To 08:00pm). More over there are specialized neurology clinics on separate week days (Epilepsy Clinic, Neuromuscular Disorders Clinic, Headache Clinic, Movement Disorders Clinic, Dementia I Memory Clinic, Multiple Sclerosis Clinic). This department has an elaborated and well organized training, teaching and evaluation programmes for postgraduate (FCPS/MD Neurology), house officers and undergraduates.



This programme comprises of daily clinical meetings, journal club, case presentations, guest lectures, mortality meetings, statistical meetings, postgraduates presentations, tests and TOACS on examination patterns. Unit has working guidelines and SOPs for smooth and standard working. Department has a library, 24 hour internet facilities, research room and computer room. The unit has the electrophysiology section providing services (EMG/NCS, EEG, VEPs, IOM, RNS, Botox injection (EMG guided). In collaboration with University College London, Unit conducting genetic studies in familial movement and epileptic disorders. In collaboration with University of Nebraska, USA, Department conducting research on various movement disorders. Department of neurology, along with department of pulmonology is looking after Sleep Research Lab. The team of neurology department is fully motivated and enthusiastic for the future projects that include establishment of first acute stroke centre, Neurology Research Centre (NRC), Primary Prevention in Neurology at all levels (Primordial, Primary, Secondary & tertiary).

Neurosurgery Unit-I

Professor Rizwan Masood Butt

Neurosurgery Unit-I is a 121 bedded teaching unit in Punjab Institute of Neurosciences/ Lahore General Hospital, Lahore. Prof. Rizwan Masood Butt (MBBS, MD, FRCS, FCPS) is the head of the Department. Our unit is independently functioning with highly qualified faculty members including 1 Associate Professor, 5 Assistant Professors and 4 Senior Registrars. We have 8 Medical Officer along with 25 post graduate residents. We also have house officers and medical students on rotation in this unit.



On average, the elective admissions are about 10200 per year while 400 elective surgeries are performed monthly in the eight state of the art theatres, whereby brain and spinal surgeries are performed with the help of microscopes, endoscopes and conventional approaches. A variety of functional neurosurgical procedures are done in multidisciplinary approaches training the upcoming neurosurgeons. In emergency department there are 27200 admissions and 120 emergency operations are performed per month. The OPD visits are about 36600 yearly. This department has an elaborate and highly organized, international standard teaching and training programs for undergraduates, house officers, post graduate residents and rotational foreign fellows. The teaching program consists of daily teaching rounds followed by surgical evaluation meetings, weekly case presentations, journal club meetings and monthly grand rounds where foreign faculty guest speakers are invited for continuous medical education program to keep pace with the international neurosurgical protocols. Post graduates presentation, monthly tests and TOACS examinations are organized for preparing for the upcoming exams. Post graduate residents along with the consultants are working on the synopsis, thesis and clinical research work. We are the active member of CRASH Trial-3, a research study with collaboration of London School of Hygiene. This unit is recognized for MS, FCPS.

DEPARTMENTAL PROFILES

Neurosurgery Unit-II

Professor Khalid Mehmood

Neurosurgery Unit II is a 90 bedded teaching unit of Punjab institute of Neurosciences, headed by Prof. Khalid Mahmood. We are independently functioning Professorial Neurosurgery Unit along with a team of 1 Associate Professor, 3 Assistant Professors, 4 Senior Registrars and 25 post graduate trainees.

Our motto is to train doctors in Neurosurgery at par with international standards and provide congenial environment for clinical research that will help future generations of Pakistan. There is robust teaching and training program with grand teaching rounds, CPC, journal club and mortality meetings along with state of the art Neurosurgery skill lab. This Unit has two OPD Days in which average 250-300 patients are seen. We have two full day elective operation lists as well as two twenty four hours emergency days cover along with Sunday emergency cover on our turn. Department performs about 3000 emergency and elective surgical cases per annum. Minimal access surgery, Endoscopic Endonasal skull base surgery, awake craniotomies, Endoscopic spinal surgery, advanced spinal instrumentation and Neuroendovascular work is a routine with us. Professor Dr. Khalid Mahmood pioneered Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS) surgery for Parkinsonism in Pakistan on 30th November 2014. We are the National referral centre for Deep Brain stimulation (DBS), thalamotomy, pallidotomy, capsulotomy, RF Rhizotomy procedures in Pakistan. Multiple research projects are going on in this unit. This unit is a part of currently undergoing international CRASH-3 trial. This unit is recognized for both MS and FCPS Neurosurgery programs.



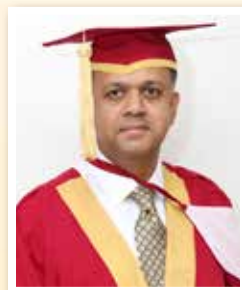
Neurosurgery Unit-III

Neurosurgery Unit III is a 100+ bedded teaching unit in the Punjab Institute of Neurosciences /Lahore General Hospital, Lahore. Prof. Dr. Asif Bashir (MBBS, M.D, FAANS, FACS) is the head of department who joined in November 2017 from USA. In this unit we have 2 Associate Professors, 1 Assistant Professor, 5 Senior Registrars and 8 Medical Officers along with 25 post graduate residents.

On average, the elective admissions are about 10200 per year while 400 elective surgeries are performed monthly in the eight state of the art theaters. Emergency admissions are 27200 and 120+ emergency operations are done per month. The OPD visits are about 36600. The department has elaborate and highly organized, international standard teaching and training program for under graduates, house officers, post graduate residents and rotational foreign fellows. The teaching program consists of daily teaching rounds, surgical evaluation meetings, weekly case presentations, journal club meetings and monthly Grand Rounds where foreign faculty guests are invited for continuous medical education program to keep pace with the international neurosurgical protocol. Post graduates presentations, monthly tests and TOACS examinations are organized for the preparation of the upcoming exams. Post graduate residents with their consultants are working on the synopsis, thesis and clinical research work. We are the active member of CRASH Trial-3, a research study with collaboration of London School of Hygiene. This unit is recognized for MS & FCPS post graduate training.

This unit is also pioneer in Minimally Invasive Brain & Spine surgeries including; Functional Neuro Surgery and Minimal Invasive Spinal Surgery i.e: Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS) for Parkinson's disease, Radio Frequency Rhizotomy (RFR) for Trigeminal Neuralgia (TGN), Neuro Navigation Guided brain surgery, Percutaneous Transpedicular Fixation for traumatic spine & Endonasal skull base surgery.

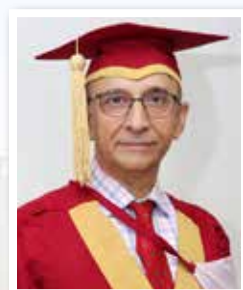

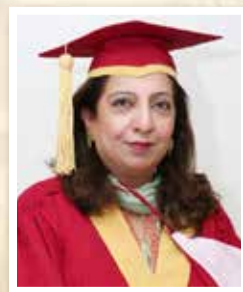


Obstetrics & Gynaecology Unit-II

Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology unit II is headed by Professor Alia Bashir. Dr. Shabnam Muhammad Ali is Associate Professor, Dr. Farzana Latif and Dr. Naila Yasmeen are the Assistant Professors. Our unit provides emergency services every alternate day & department caters annual births of around 5500-6000. Our unit confers its services on three OPD days, where on average 450-500 patients are attended every day. Moreover there are 3 specialized clinics, i.e; infertility clinic, fetometrnl clinic and urogynaecology clinic run by our department. OBGY department has developed SOPs for smooth & standard management of patients. Laparoscopic procedures are also carried out on elective lists.

This unit is recognized for FCPS, MCPS, MS & DGO training. This department has an elaborated and well organized structured training, teaching and evaluation programmes for undergraduate, house officers and postgraduates. This programme comprises of daily clinical meetings, journal club, case presentations, guest lectures, skill demonstrations, maternal & perinatal mortality meetings, statistical meetings, postgraduate presentations, test and TOACs on examination patterns. Department has a library, 24 hour internet facility conference room and computer room. This unit has also conducted three days intensive postgraduate training course in Obs & Gynae exactly on the examination pattern. There are four books on the credit of the Unit on Obs & Gynae. Moreover 30 research projects are going on in this unit.



DEPARTMENTAL PROFILES

Ophthalmology Unit-I

Professor Muhammad Moin

It is one of the leading Ophthalmology Units in the province with the latest machinery and providing different sub-specialty services to the patients. The department is headed by Prof. Muhammad Moin who is a fellowship trained Oculoplastics and Vitreoretinal surgeon. Dr. Lubna Siddique and Dr. Arooj Amjad are senior registrars in the unit along with 2 vitreo-retinal fellows. The Department is renowned for its vitreoretinal subspecialty which caters for all complicated retinal disorders. We also offer advanced Oculoplastics and Orbital surgery providing high volume service to such patients. Anterior segment surgery is also done using the most advanced machinery. A dedicated Ophthalmology Diagnostic department is established in the unit. We believe in prevention of Ophthalmological diseases for which we have established Retinal screening services in the Diabetic Medical Center of the hospital and a Retinopathy of Prematurity service in the Neonatology department.



The department is responsible for teaching and training undergraduates and postgraduate medical students and nursing staff. Teaching of postgraduate trainees comprises of bed side teaching, seminars, lectures, journal club, CPC and surgical training under supervision. A dedicated ophthalmic wet lab is available for surgical training of residents in basic & advanced skills. The Department is recognized by College of Physicians and Surgeons Pakistan for FCPS and MCPS in Ophthalmology. and Subspecialty fellowship in Vitreo-retinal Surgery. We also have students of MS and DOMS programs run by the University of Health Sciences. All the 3 units combined take care of about 20,000 patients in the outpatients department and performs 2,000 eye surgeries every year. Original articles are published quarterly in the department in peer reviewed journals. The department also hosts various workshops and seminars for ophthalmologists around the year.

Ophthalmology Unit-II

Professor Mahmood Saeed

Ophthalmology Unit-II is a 21 bedded teaching unit of Post Graduate Medical Institute / Ameer ud Din Medical College/Lahore General Hospital Lahore. Prof. Mahmood Saeed is the head of department, Dr. Hussain Ahmed Khaqan is Associate Professor and there is one Senior Registrar Dr. Rizwan Ahmed, one Medical Officer and 11 PGR in this unit. This unit admits about 1014 patients per year with weekly admission rate of 30-50. This unit has two OPD days in which average 300-400 patients are seen. More over Laser and Diagnostic Centre facilities are available here. The department has elaborate and well organized training, teaching and evaluation programmes for postgraduates, house officers and undergraduates. This programme comprises of clinical meetings, Journal club, case presentations, guest lectures, skill demonstrations, tests and TOACS on examination patterns. Unit has work guidelines and SOPs for smooth working. Department has E-library, 24 hour internet facility, conference room, research room and computer room. Moreover 10 research projects are going on in this unit under supervision of Associate Prof. Hussain Ahmed Khaqan. This unit is recognized for FCPS, MCPS, DOMS and MS trainings.

Ophthalmology Unit-III

Dr. Zubair Saleem

Ophthalmology Unit-III of Ameer-ud-din Medical College/Lahore General Hospital is actively contributing its share in the progress of Ophthalmology department. It is a 20-bedded unit headed by Associate Professor Dr. Zubair Saleem. We have a dedicated team catering for the needs of a large volume of ophthalmic patients. On each of our two OPD days, an average of 350-400 patients are examined. We have an admission rate of about 30-40 patients per week. In addition to routine anterior segment surgery we offer advanced oculoplastic and vitreo-retinal surgery to our patients. Excellent ophthalmic diagnostic and laser facilities are also available for the patients. The unit is recognized for the teaching and training of undergraduate as well as postgraduate medical students. Currently, postgraduate trainees enrolled in FCPS, MS and DOMS programmes are under training in the unit. A well organized teaching and training programme exists in the form of bed-side teaching, case presentation, lectures, journal club and surgical workshops. Various research studies are being conducted by the postgraduate trainees. We seek to excel further in our efforts to serve the patients and to promote ophthalmology by imparting quality training to the future ophthalmologists.

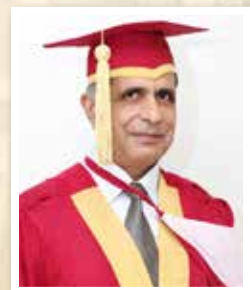


Orthopaedic Unit-I

Professor Irfan Mehboob

Orthopedic Unit-I is a 45 bedded teaching unit of PGMI/AMC/LGH Lahore. Professor Dr. Irfan Mehboob is the head of department and Dr. Adnan Latif Malik is Assistant Professor. There are 6 Senior Registrars in this unit. 560 patients are admitted in this unit every year and 40 to 45 patients are operated on an average per week. This unit has three OPD days, with an average of 250-300 patients per day. All kinds of Orthopaedic procedures are being performed including trauma orthopaedic surgery, spine surgery, arthroscopy, reconstructive surgery, arthroplasty, tumor surgery and pediatric orthopaedic surgery.

This Department has an elaborated and well organized training, teaching and evaluation programs for postgraduates, house officers and undergraduates. There are daily morning meetings, Journal club, case presentations, guest lectures and surgical skills workshops. Every year MOCK examinations and intensive review courses are conducted for the candidates appearing in FCPS and MS part-II exams and candidates from all over Pakistan participate in such activities. Moreover, to enhance the knowledge of residents this unit has its own library with up to date reading material, conference room, research room, and its own computer lab with internet access. This unit has the pride to conduct First Orthopaedic Advance Trauma Course under the umbrella of Pakistan Orthopaedic Association. This unit is recognized for MS & FCPS training.

Orthopaedic Unit-II

Professor Muhammad Hanif Mian

Department of Orthopedic Surgery Unit II of Lahore General Hospital /PGMI /Ameer Ud Din Medical College Lahore is a 35 bedded department headed by Professor Dr. Muhammad Hanif Mian with Dr. Muhammad Khalid Ur Rehman as Assistant Professor, 8 Senior Registrars and 10 Post graduate residents.

We are providing services to all trauma patients with special interest in complicated trauma like acetabular & pelvic injuries. We are the only department in public sector providing state of the art spinal surgery facilities including deformity correction, decompressions and minimal invasive spine (MIS) procedures.

The department is having well organized training & teaching programme for the post graduates and under graduates in the form of morning trauma meetings, bed side teaching & weekly case presentations and discussions along with journal club.

The department has active participations & presentations at national and international forums. We have also participation in fortnightly meetings, symposia and lectures which are targeted towards the improvement of clinical and practical skills. The trainees are involved in all the routine operative surgeries under supervision both in the emergency and elective operating rooms.

The department is providing almost all levels of care which are better than any other tertiary care center in the town but still we have to work hard in improving patient's care. In near future, we are planning to establish state of the art Arthroscopy and Sports injury center along with improved spinal surgery facility with most modern gadgets and Spinal Fellowship programme (M.S.) as well.



Otorhinolaryngology Unit-I

Professor Najam-ul-Hasnain Khan

Otorhinolaryngology (ENT) department of Ameer ud Din Medical College /Postgraduate Medical Institute consists of two wards ENT-1 and ENT-2 headed by Prof. Dr. Najam ul Husnain Khan and Associate Professor Dr. Tahir Rashid respectively. Each ward has 20 beds and there is a side room in ENT-2 as well. ENT-1 ward has 1 Associate Professor, 1 Assistant Professor, 1 Senior Registrar and 12 PGRs.

ENT-2 ward has 1 Assistant professor, 1 Senior Registrar and 9 PGRs. ENT Ameer ud Din Medical College / Postgraduate Medical Institute offers post graduate training in programmes of MCPS, MS, DLO and FCPS. ENT Ameer ud Din Medical College / Postgraduate Medical Institute has facilities of Endoscopic surgeries including endoscopic sinus surgery, esophagoscopy, Direct Laryngoscopy and Bronchoscopy.



Otorhinolaryngology Unit-II

Dr. Tahir Rashid

ENT Unit II of Ameer-ud-Din Medical College/PGMI/ Lahore General Hospital is a 18 bedded. Dr. Tahir Rashid is the head; Dr. Dawood Saleem and Dr. Aamir Ayub are the assistant professors. There is one senior registrar and four medical officers along with ten PG students of MS and DLO. This unit admits around 800 patients per year with 600 major surgeries 1100 minor cases. This unit has three OPDs per week with 250-300 patients per OPD.

ENT is fully equipped with endoscopic evaluations and surgeries for nasal diseases. Also has laser facility for laryngeal disease. State of the art microscopes are also available. This unit also has a audiology clinic, we also deal with head and neck surgeries for cancer patients.

This department has a well-organized teaching and training program for undergraduate and post-graduate students. This program comprises of daily rounds, clinical meetings, case presentations and journal club meetings. Department has a library, class room and internet facility for research. On an average 2-3 research papers are published in a year. This unit is recognized for MCPS, FCPS, MS and DLO training.

Pathology Department

Prof. Muhammad Tariq Hamid Rahmani

Pathology Department of Postgraduate Medical Institute/Ameer-ud-Din Medical College, Lahore/ General Hospital comprises of Histopathology, Hematology, Microbiology, Chemical Pathology, Molecular Biology Section along with Specialized Research Lab and Emergency Lab. The department is headed by Prof. Dr. Muhammad Tariq Hamid Rahmani. There are 3 Associate Professors, 8 Assistant Professors and 4 Senior Demonstrators along with PMO & APMOS. This department caters to all the patients of LGH with an average of 400,000/year and 2700.000-3000,000 tests performed/year. The central lab and emergency lab are open 24/7 to cater the emergency tests. Central research lab is designed to perform state of the art specialized tests.

The department has an elaborated and well organized training, teaching and evaluation programmes for post graduate and undergraduate students. This program comprises of daily lectures, seminars, journal club meetings, case presentations, practical teaching, and technical skill demonstrations. The department also evaluate the students by tests and assessments according to UHS examination pattern. Unit has working guidelines and SOPs for smooth and standard working. In addition department has 24 hours internet facility and online reporting system. This department is recognized for FCPS Hematology and M.Phil in all disciplines of Pathology. Currently 25 PGRs are enrolled in these programmes and around 30 research projects are going on.

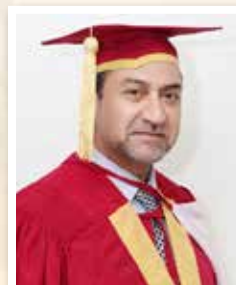


Pediatrics Department

Professor Agha Shabbir Ali

Professor Muhammad Shahid

Pediatrics Unit-I/II is a teaching unit of Lahore General Hospital/Ameer-ud-Din Medical College/Post Graduate Medical Institute, headed by Prof. Agha Shabbir Ali (Unit-I) and Prof. Muhammad Shahid (Unit-II) along with a team of 2 Associate Professors, 2 Assistant Professors, 8 Senior Registrars and 40 post graduate trainees. This unit is 70 bedded, consisting of Pediatric ICU, Neonatology including Neonatal ICU, Emergency, Outdoor Clinic, Medical section, Oncology and Dengue wards. The Intensive Care Unit consists of eight beds where ventilators and cardiac monitoring facilities are provided. There is an in-unit state-of-the-art classroom and a library with the latest editions of relevant reference books and journals which provides a congenial environment for clinical research. Morning class is the hallmark of teaching activities where regular sessions of long cases, short cases and research related activities are conducted under supervision of consultants. The department is equipped with an in-house laboratory for rapid access to investigations including Portable X-ray and Ultrasound facilities. Pediatrics department manages on average 9000 emergency patients, 5000 outdoor patients, 500 ward admissions, 2000 neonatal admissions and 80 ICU admissions on a monthly basis. The department believes in Multidisciplinary Approach to management and prevention of pediatric diseases and as such interdepartmental relations are well maintained with all indoor units of the hospital. Peri-natal mortality meetings are conducted with OB/GYN departments monthly for the improvement of maternal and fetal outcomes. Prof. Agha Shabbir Ali pioneered management of osteogenesis Imperfecta in Pakistan in 2004 via Osteogenesis Imperfecta Clinic where 35 patients are registered and receiving treatment as well as supportive therapy. He also introduced Pediatric Palliative Care Society, Hematology & Oncology services and Shared Care Project with Oncology Department of the Children Hospital at Lahore General Hospital as well as organized numerous workshops and intensive review courses for FCPS and MRCP students. A number of Research Publications are associated with the unit as well as a number of National & International collaborative programs including Retinopathy of Prematurity (PROPERA) and TB Control Program. The department is also involved in Outreach Training programs at a number of Hospitals and cities.

Pharmacology Department

Dr. Moneeb Ashraf

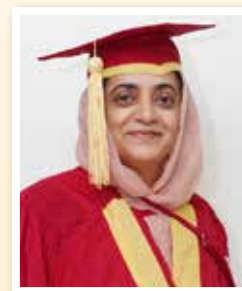
Headed by Dr. Moneeb Ashraf, Assistant professor with his team, Pharmacology department is a well organized and well-equipped unit of PGMI/Ameer ud Din Medical College, Lahore. It not only caters for the needs of undergraduate M.B.B.S students, post graduate research and academic activities are hallmark of the department. Clinical postgraduate students of MD, MS and diploma classes are taught their respective pharmacology course through special classes while a full time two year research based M.Phil Pharmacology program is also run at the department. Department has a spacious, air-conditioned post graduate lab with state of the art equipment used in pharmacology research. It has facilities for extraction of active pharmacological principles from different natural resources and a properly managed and technically supported animal house is attached with department for in vivo animal testing of these agents. The pharmacology lab is also capable of in-vitro studies furnished with almost all necessary gadgets used for this purpose. A special computerized database recording system is also in place for isolated tissue experiments. Besides supporting practical research work, department also arranges different workshops and guest lectures to empower its faculty and students with essential basic techniques and upcoming knowledge – the diversity of topics ranging from animal handling, research methodology, learning to use analytical software like SPSS to the hands-on training of latest technology like real time PCR. Research work done in the department is also published in different standard journals and is presented in national and international conferences.



Physiology Department

Professor Muniza Saeed

Physiology is an important applied field in health sciences and is the core of all medical research being done globally. Physiology department of AMC/PGMI is one of the meticulous departments of the institute. It is headed by Prof. Dr. Muniza Saeed. There are two Assistant Professors Dr. Naghmana Lateef and Dr. Hifza Noor Lodhi along with 11 demonstrators. Faculty is actively involved in teaching, research work, attending conferences and presenting papers at different conferences and seminars. Department is dedicated to understanding fundamental physiological processes and helping students to translate it into clinical care. The Physiology department has elaborate and well structured training, teaching and evaluation program for undergraduate students. These programs include interactive lectures, hands on training on data acquisition system, problem based learning sessions, small group discussions and undergraduate research projects. Hard work is reflected by the tremendous result of the annual university examination with nineteen distinctions in Part I and nine in Part II, along with hundred percent result this years in the subject of physiology. The department provides an excellent environment for postgraduate studies in basic and clinical disciplines which include M.Phil, diploma and MD/MS/MDS. Postgraduate students are encouraged to take on research projects other than their thesis, along with seminars, journal clubs, research methodology workshops, lab meetings, and informal departmental gatherings which provide PG students and faculty with opportunities to participate in research discussions and present their work in conferences and publish it. They are skilled to implement current teaching methods to be better teachers and responsible persons.

Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Department

Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery department is a 20 bedded teaching unit of Lahore General Hospital. Dr. Yawar Sajjad is the head of the department. Dr. Mehvish Murtaza and Dr. Roomana Akhlaque are two Assistant Professors of this unit. There is one Senior Registrar in this unit. This unit admits about 700-750 patients per year. This unit has two OPD days in which average 50-70 patients are seen with consultation provided to the referred and outdoor patients.

This department has an elaborated and well organized training, teaching and evaluation programs for postgraduates, house officers and undergraduates. This program comprises of daily clinical meetings, Journal Club, case presentations, guest lectures, skill demonstrations, mortality/morbidity meetings, statistical meetings, post graduate presentations, tests and TOACS on examination patterns. Unit has working guidelines and SOPs for smooth and standard working. Department has e-library, conference room, and computer room. Multiple research projects are going on in this unit. This unit is recognized for FCPS and MS training.



Psychiatry And Behavioral Sciences Department

Professor Altaf Qadir Khan

Department of Psychiatry is a 34 bedded teaching unit of Lahore General Hospital Lahore. It is headed by Prof. Altaf Qadir Khan, Dr. Aysha Rasheed is working as Assistant Professor. Two clinical psychologists, Asma Gul as Senior Clinical Psychologist and Hira Khurram are giving their indoor and outdoor services. Department provides indoor services, on average there is admission of 35-40 patients/month. Out door services are provided on daily basis in which average 80-100 patients are seen.

There is a 10 bedded addiction ward in which detoxification services are provided to drug addicts. In addition counselling, motivation and rehabilitation are also given on outdoor basis. Forensic Psychiatric services are provided on indoor and outdoor basis.

This department has well organized training programs for postgraduates, undergraduates and house officers. Training comprises of lectures, daily clinical meeting, clinical rounds, case presentation, case conference, journal club and research meetings. Skill is tested by tests and TOACS on examination patterns. Department has a library, 24 hour internet facility is available in library, conference room and computer room. There are currently seven research projects are going on in this department. The department is recognized for FCPS, MD and DPM training.



DEPARTMENTAL PROFILES

Pulmonology Department

Prof. Khalid Waheed

The department of Pulmonology, PGMI/AMC/LGH headed by Prof. Dr. Khalid Waheed is offering both indoor and outdoor services. The 6 days a week OPD has a turnover of over 2000 patients/month. The OPD is also supervised by Consultant Pulmonologists on daily basis. A separate TB-DOT OPD is working in collaboration with National TB Control Program to provide excellent TB care facilities on outdoor basis. GENEXPERT, which is latest and state of art TB Diagnostic test, has also been started. Twenty indoor beds having round the clock central oxygen supply, are providing care under supervision of qualified consultant Pulmonologists.

The department provides on call consultation services by consultants to other departments as well. In house diagnostic services including Spirometry, Bronchoscopy (washing, brushing, biopsy, lavage), Pleural biopsy, 6MWT, Ultrasound as well as ultrasound guided procedures. Therapeutic services apart from regular in patient care including Non-invasive ventilation and chest intubation. Obstructive Sleep apnea is a new emerging entity having a huge disease burden. Sleep Lab having state of the art Polysomnography (Sleep Study) has also been started for the benefit of patients. The department is recognized for FCPS, MCPS and MD training in the specialty of Pulmonology. The Department provides training facility for DTCD (Diploma in Tuberculosis & Chest Diseases) as well as rotational training of MD & F.C.P.S residents from different medical departments. Daily teaching rounds and frequent bed side teaching activities are arranged for training of undergraduates, house officers and PG students.

A regular CME program on Wednesday, video based learning classes and clinical case presentations / monthly mortality conference/ multidisciplinary meetings with Radiology and Pathology department on alternating Saturdays under the supervision of consultants is going on side by side.

National events in pulmonary diseases like World TB Day, World Asthma Day and No Smoking day are also observed regularly. Awareness about these diseases is highlighted for patients and colleague doctors by CME activity, banners and informative walks.

Radiology Department

Radiology Department of LGH established in 1966 is the largest Diagnostic and Imaging Facility in the whole province. At present it is equipped with latest diagnostic facilities like MRI, CT, Angiography, DR & CR systems, Ultrasound and Mammography. All sorts of interventional and contrast studies are being done on Angiography, CT and X-Ray. The 3.0-T MRI is one of its kind in public sector in the Punjab. Acute Stroke center provides facilities for neuro-endovascular procedures. Biplane DSA with Dyna CT is the state of the art.

At present, Radiology department is headed by Prof. Dr. Saima Ameer. The department is providing teaching and training to under graduate and post graduate students of AMC, PGMI and CPSP through a very competent and experienced faculty. Post graduate programs include FCPS, MCPS and DMRD.

We are catering not only patients coming to LGH but also referrals from all over the country, especially in the field of Neuro Imaging. We serve the patients in OPD, 6 days a week for 16 hours in CT and MRI and for 12 hours in other modalities. Round the clock 24/7 Radio-diagnostic facility is available in Emergency. Daily average turnover of patients being served in OPD is 600. Whereas average turnover in Emergency Radiology is 700. This includes patients coming for CT, X-Ray and ultrasound. New machines to be acquired in the upcoming year include MRI, CT, fluoroscopy, DR systems, 3D mammography and high-end color Doppler ultrasound machines.

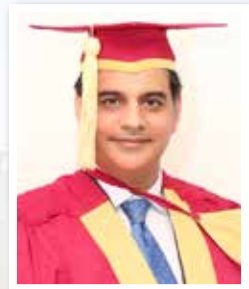

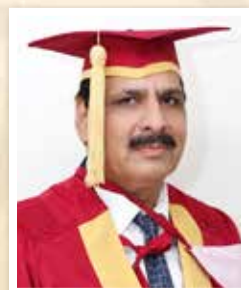

Surgical Unit-III is a 35 bedded teaching unit of Lahore General Hospital, Lahore. It is headed by Prof. Dr. Sikandar Hayat Gondal who is also Head of Surgical Department. Dr. Amna Javed is his Associate Professor, and Dr. Abdul Waheed Khan and Dr. Ahmad Naeem Akhtar are serving as Assistant Professors and there are 3 devoted Senior Registrars. On average about 250 Patients are admitted both from outpatient as well as from Emergency Department in this unit. This unit is holding 2 OPDs Per week with an average of 260-350 Patients with 8 elective lists per month. Tumor cases especially breast and Gastrointestinal are taken up with special interest. The unit is performing basic as well as advanced laparoscopic surgeries on elective lists. Moreover there are three specialized clinics being run by the unit like breast clinic, hepatobiliary clinic, head and neck and hernia clinic.

This department has an elaborated and well organized training, teaching and evaluation programs for Postgraduates, Undergraduates and House officers.

There are weekly lectures, daily clinical classes in ward & OPD, evening emergency classes as well as monthly CPC meetings. The Department also holds Clinical meetings, Journal Club, monthly GI meetings, MDT, Guest lectures, M&M and Audits. The department has successfully conducted many hands on workshops on Trauma management, BLS, Basic Surgical & Laparoscopic Skills., Unit has Working Guidelines and SOPs according to MSDS portfolio

Department has a Library and 24 hours internet Facility, Conference room, Private rooms, dressing room, and Computer room, Department has made 3 Research article publications in the last year. Moreover 6 research projects are going on in this unit. This unit is recognized for both MS & FCPS training Programs



Urology Department

Professor Muhammad Nazir

The Department of Urology, Dialysis & Kidney Transplant was established in 1981. Prof. Farrukh Ahmad Khan took over as first head of the department, at PGMI / Lahore General Hospital, Lahore. Now the department is upgraded by untiring efforts of Prof. Dr. Mohammad Nazir and having state of the art facilities. We have 70 indoor beds & 3 private rooms, a separate space for OPD and 33 hemodialysis machines working in three shifts. All patients of Chronic Renal Failure are getting the medicines from hospital. We are a recognized unit for kidney transplant by HOTA Punjab & subsequent immunosuppression is also provided by the hospital. Extracorporeal Shockwave (Lithotripsy) is available for kidney stones, Minimal invasive surgery for lower urinary tract like TUR-P, TUR-BT, Internal Urethrotomy, Litholapaxy, Ureterorenoscopy, Pneumatic Lithotripsy, PCNL, Laproscopic Urological Procedures and Laser Enucleation of prostate are regularly being performed in the department. Laser is also used for breaking stones anywhere in the urinary system and treating bad stricture. The facilities mentioned above are most modern and we have now entered into an era of non invasive and minimal invasive surgery. With these facilities we are comparable any department of urology in Pakistan.

We have 23 Postgraduate students amongst which 20 are enrolled as M. S & 3 are as FCPS residents.

About Professor Ameer-ud-Din

It is said that nations are known by their heroes. Our institution takes its name after a valued and worthy gem, a renowned Pakistani surgeon and Emeritus Professor of surgery. Pakistan nation will never ever forget Prof. Ameer ud Din and keep his memories alive in the hearts and minds of the people. The academic council of PGMI and Heads all departments of LGH under the auspicious chairmanship of the Principal Prof. Tariq Salahuddin unanimously decided to name the Medial College affiliated with LGH after the name of Professor Emeritus Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din. After making this glorious decision, the committee sent this proposal to the Health Department of Punjab.



The people who lead the way forward, the people who are as the beacons of light in darkness, are the people like Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din. If such people did not exist, humanity would have died. Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din got admission in King Edward Medical College on 29th October 1921. At that time all the Professors, Instructors and other staff was under Indian Medical Services and they were all British and Australian. Their standards of discipline & teaching were sky high. Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din graduated in 1926. He had the honour of serving as House Surgeon under Colonel Boot (Viceroy's Surgeon) from 27th March 1928 to July 1928. Lt. Col. Bhatrucha was the first ever Professor of Surgery in India. Prof. Ameer ud Din worked with him and followed his footsteps in all of his professional life. He passed his FRCS exam in 1931 and was appointed as Demonstrator Anatomy and in charge Officer of Surgical Outpatient Department at King Edward Medical College, Lahore. When regular professors used to go abroad to spend their summer vacations the Professors of Anatomy Department used to work at their posts for three months. Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din worked in partners with Professor of Anatomy at that time. In 1937 Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din was appointed as Surgeon and Demonstrator in Amritsar School of Medicine where he used to perform Surgical procedures on reform basis. He became very popular amongst the Hindu traders, businessmen and industrialists of Amritsar. Due to this fame and recognition, he was appointed Professor of Surgery at King Edward Medical College. The Hindus of Amritsar requested the Governor of the Punjab to send Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din back to Amritsar. Governor Punjab asked him if he wanted to go back to Amritsar but he preferred serving in his native city Lahore and he considered it as a great honor to be a part of Surgical Team at Mayo Hospital Lahore. After the partition of the sub-continent Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din was appointed as a Senior Professor of Surgery and he worked tirelessly day and night to attend to the wounds of immigrants. In 1949, Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din as invited to the United States of America by the US Government where he got a chance to work with renowned American Surgeon Dr. Lalika and the famous Dr. Sweet. He also worked in the Urology Department in United Kingdom as well. The Dean of Surgery Department of the Royal College of Surgeons, Sir. Gordon-Taylor used to consider Prof. Ameer ud Din as one of the top 20 surgeons of the world. Besides his administrative and clinical approach he had keen interest in research as well. His research paper "Etiology of gall stones" was published during 1948-1949. His relentless efforts were awarded with TAMGHA-

I-PAKISTAN in 1958 and SITAR-E-IMTIAZ in 1960. He had indeed served as an architect of Pakistan not just by his exquisite endeavors in field of surgery but by being altruistic and generous.

It was a great honor to work as House surgeon under Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din. All the highest ranking medical students who wanted to pass Surgery as a career used to work with him. And all of them turned out to be famous & renowned Professors of Surgery. Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din had many students in Pakistan and all over the world. In 1957 the Pakistan Society for Rehabilitation was formed and he was the first President of this society. Orthopedic surgeon Dr Ayub Khan was the general secretary and the first office of the society was made in the outpatient department of Mayo Hospital Lahore. Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din was not only a good Doctor & but also a brave and generous person. Kind and humility were his traits for life. He used to help poor patients and deserving students by giving financial assistance at a personal level

Former President of Pakistan, Field Marshal, Gen. Muhammad Ayub Khan once took on appointment for medical consultation. He could not reach on the scheduled appointment due to some reason but when he did, the consultant refused to see him. The consultant maintained that President's scheduled appointment was missed and cannot be adjusted on someone else's time, therefore he has to take another appointment. The President apologized to that great consultant without a frown and took an appointment for later and left. Who can defy the ruler of time? This courage was not ordinary. This discipline, authority regulation, professionalism and abiding by the rules belonged to the most extra ordinary surgeon of the time who could clearly differentiate between ordinary & non ordinary. This great personality was Dr. Ameer ud Din, who is not here with us today, but he will live forever because of his professionalism & his love for humanity. Such great people do not die they live on for eternity in hearts & minds of people.

He gave a huge sacrifice during the formation of Pediatric Surgery Department at Mayo Hospital Lahore. He sold his house situated in Gulberg Lahore and donated the money for building the ward. During his tenure as chief of chest surgery department, he used to arrange food for the patients from his own pocket. In recognition of his contributions, government awarded him with honor of "EMERITUS PROFESSOR OF SURGERY. EMERITUS means "VETERAN SOLDIER" and he actually proved to be one. Professor Emeritus is the one who stays in job till life and this honor is bestowed upon the Professors who have highest level of skill and are one of a kind in this profession. Prof. Dr. Ameer ud Din stayed as the chief of chest surgery department Mayo Hospital till the last days of his life. He was an expert in cholecystectomy. His expertise included finesse and speed in his professional work. . His devotions, dedications, actions, disciplines, and resolutions demands something bigger from us.
